

WHY BELLINGHAM

Bellingham is officially known as the Gateway to Northumberland National Parks, but is affectionately known as **Middle-Diddle** due to its central location making it an ideal place to stay with East & West Coasts being less than 1 hour away as are the Lakes, Hadrian's Wall and Scotland, with Edinburgh being within reach at well under 2 hours.

Apart from the superb facilities and historic attractions offered by Bellingham, including one of the few villages to have public toilets. The surrounding area has a vast amount of beautiful countryside with plenty of organised activities, such as Outward Bound areas, Historical Railways, Shooting/Hunting, some of the best Salmon Fishing in the country, excellent 18 Hole Golf Course, Quad Bike riding, Horse Riding, Cycle and Walking routes.
